Collection of Feedback from Students, Teachers, Alumni, and Employers:

The College collects feedback on curriculum aspects and courses from different stakeholders such as the students, alumni, Faculty, and Employers. The Institution established Academic Council to ensure and analyze academic excellence at student and faculty levels. The Periodical analysis is made by Academic Council from the following: student performance, faculty performance in every semester, utilization of infrastructure, and requirements for quality enrichment. College collects the feedback physically from stockholders viz. Students and Teachers on Curriculum which is prescribed by the university, further college website invites all stakeholders to provide feedback through online.

The feedback of students, faculty, employer and alumni is significant in the improvement of teaching and learning process of an institution. During the academic session of 2021-22, the college also obtained feedback from all the main stakeholders' viz., the students, faculty, employer and alumni of the college. In this regard, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college designed the questionnaire separately for students, faculty, employer and alumni. Here, the term student is meant for the student who has completed at least one academic session in the college and employer means the employer of the students of the college. The questionnaire mainly covered all the issues relating to the curriculum. For the present survey total 400 students, 18 faculty members, 17 Employers and 58 alumni were selected by using the random sampling. The results obtained from the survey are analyzed as follows:

Student Feedback Analysis

Students are one of the most significant stakeholders for any educational institution. Their feedback is extremely valuable and can be utilized to review and enhance the teaching-learning techniques of the institution. The results obtained from the survey of the students are analyzed as follows:

Taking into account the students' feedback responses, a majority of the respondents (78.00 percent) accept that the curriculum is relevant. 80.00 percent of them accept that there is an adequate balance between the theory and practical in the curriculum. 79.00 percent of the respondents agree that the study material available in the library is good and excellent. 81.00 percent of the respondents opine that curriculum has given them opportunities to grow and learn. 90.00 percent of the students are found satisfied with the methods of teaching. 83.00 percent of them consider that the infrastructure and lab facilities for curriculum are properly available in the

college. Majority of them (87.00 percent) accept that the overall academic environment is excellent, very good or good in the college.

Alumni feedback

The college conducts an annual Alumni Meet, in which suggestions and feedback are received from Alumni students. The provided feedback data is presented to the Academic Council Meeting for necessary implementation in the curriculum. Alumni surveys are conducted during alumni interaction at the alumni association meeting held every year. Whenever any alumni visit the college, feedback is taken.
